Aim of the subject and short description	
<p>Theoretical basics of teamwork and the benefits of team implementation. This course gives an overview of Belbin team role theory and gives practical skills how to use team-role theory at teamwork. Every student gets his/her own individual team-role report to understand and analyze his/her personal strengths and allowable weaknesses. The main topics to be covered are basics of successful teamwork, team and group benefits, growth strategies of a team, team building, cooperation in the achievement of the team, the allocation of rules and responsibilities, team motivation, conflict management, and teamwork advantages.</p>
