Aim of the subject and short description	
Theoretical basics of teamwork and the benefits of team implementation. This course gives an overview of Belbin team role theory and gives practical skills how to use team-role theory at teamwork. Every student gets his/her own individual team-role report to understand and analyze his/her personal strengths and allowable weaknesses. The main topics to be covered are basics of successful teamwork, team and group benefits, growth strategies of a team, team building, cooperation in the achievement of the team, the allocation of rules and responsibilities, team motivation, conflict management, and teamwork advantages.
