Aim of the subject and short description

The aim of the study is to enable the student to acquire necessary competencies to execute the analysis of an organization and manage the development activity thereof. The master student uses different development methods on the level of an individual, group and organization, the aim of which is to ensure personal, team and organizational development. The student creates an environment that fosters devotion and creativity. The main topics include the principles, levels and tools of development management on three levels – individual, group and organization as well as the competencies of change management. Originating from the idea that development is change, the subject is tightly interwoven with the topic of change management, which touches upon the topic of change management process as well as different sub-activities to effectively manage the process, and prevent and overcome development barriers.
