Aim of the subject and short description

The purpose of the study is to enable the post-graduate to gain knowledge of the mechanisms and the most important regulations of the legislation. The main areas discussed are the legislation of Estonia and EU: the essence of the Estonian legislation. The principles of Estonia's constitution which support entrepreneurship and a balanced economic environment. Estonian legislation as a part of international legislation. Estonian legislation as a support for entrepreneurship, knowledge management and wise working. The legal aspects which are related to entrepreneurship as the support or drawback of enterprising society. The main problems of Estonian legislation – the view of legislative drafting vs practitioner. The post-graduates will solve important cases in the area as practical works. An introduction to EU institutional and substantial law. The sources of EU law and the principles and defense of human rights in EU. Legal drafting in EU and implementing European law. Jurisdictions of European Court of Justice. Internal market (free movement of goods, employees and capital and the freedom of entrepreneurship). Rules of competition. The topics will be discussed in the context of Estonia being a member of EU.
